

Suggestions for How To Sell Dinner Anywhere Tickets

For many people, starting the conversation is the hardest part. All you need to say is: "Where would you go if you could have dinner anywhere in the world?" I did that while I was on a windjammer trip and I sold 15 tickets! Someone mentioned it to her chiropractor and sold six tickets! It really is that easy. Are you going out of town for any reason: vacation, business, shopping? Take some Dinner Anywhere in the World raffle tickets with you and ask anyone, "Where would you go if you could have dinner anywhere in the world?"

Another method is to review your holiday shopping list. Tickets make amazing stocking stuffers, Thank You gifts, party favors, etc. What do you give your mail delivery person, your hairdresser, your children's teacher, that person on your list who "has everything"? Everyone enjoys a bit of fantasy and one Dinner Anywhere ticket provides way more than \$20 worth of fantasy. Is that holiday dinner conversation difficult for you? Not any longer when everyone gets brainstorming about where they'll go, because of the super fun gift you gave them!

If you have a Facebook or Instagram page, it's even easier. Just share the poster on your page and include a short blurb about it being a fundraiser for your church or saying past winners have gone to Uruguay and Spain. Encouraging your friends to share it spreads the word even farther.

Many people had great success last year just sending an email to a targeted list of their contacts including the poster, FAQs and a short personal blurb.

The Winner must decide upon a destination and a restaurant(s) by April 30, 2021. The Winner must use the Prize by January 3, 2023, **barring Covid19 restrictions**. Last year's winner was able to postpone her trip for a year. All travel arrangements must be booked through UUCB or its designated representative.

A truly great thing about the Dinner Anywhere in the World raffle is that it's a way to meet our entire fundraising goal without digging deep into our own pockets; although, you probably do want to buy at least one ticket for yourself!

We cannot send tickets through the mail, so I recommend taking a photo of completed tickets and email/ texting them to the recipient. You may then mail them the stubs. Remember to keep the contact portion of the ticket and get those back to Anna or Cayla (when you pick up more tickets to sell, because it was so easy :-)
